

# KF FLASHER

**Hook:** Curved caddis 18-24

**Thread:** Black 8/0

**Rib:** Fine silver or copper wire

**Wing:** Pearl UV Krystal flash

**Thorax:** Superfine dubbing black, mahogany  
or gray

**Head:** Thread

1) Begin this fly by placing a debarbed hook into the vice. Start the thread just behind the eye and wrap back into the bend of the hook. Tie in the wire at this point and wrap the thread forward to the thorax, forming a smooth even body. Counter wrap the wire forward in even wraps making sure to let the thread color show through.

2) Take two strands of the Krystal flash fold them over the thread and tie them down where the thorax will be. Trim the wing so it will be about 2/3 the length of the body. Now take a small amount of the dubbing and spin it onto the thread, wrap the dubbing around the hook making sure to make one or two wraps behind the wing to help it stand up a little. Form a small neat head and tie off the thread, trim and it is finished.
