

TRICO POLY-WING SPINNER

Hook: Standard dry 12 - 22

Thread: Brown 6/0—8/0

Wing: White Antron or Poly yarn

Tail: Dun hackle fibers or Micro fibets

Abdomen: Dubbed Olive, Brown, Black

Thorax: Dubbed Brown

Head: Thread

1) Begin this fly by placing a debarbed hook into the vice and starting the thread just behind the eye wrapping back towards the bend, *don't* trim the tag end of the thread yet. Taking a small clump of Antron tie in the wing at the front of the hook using figure 8 wraps to secure it so it lays down flat. Now wrap the thread back to the bend of the hook keeping the tag end of the thread on top of the hook.

2) At the bend of the hook tie in several hackle fibers to form the tail; using the tag end of the thread bring it between the fibers splitting them, tie off the thread and cut it. Next dub a tapered body towards the wings. Next use the brown dubbing to form the thorax of the fly, form a neat head and whip finish it.
