

ZEBRA MIDGE

Hook: TMC 2487 or equivalent
sz 16 - 24

Thread: 8/0 Black

Body: Thread

Rib: Silver wire

1) Place a debarbed hook into the vise, start the thread just short of the eye of the hook and wrap back into the bend.

2) Tie in the silver wire at this point and wrap the thread forward to where the thorax will be. Be sure to wrap evenly to form a smooth body on the fly. Spiral wrap the wire up to the thorax, tie it off and remove the remaining. When trimming wire, don't cut it with your scissors, instead, bend it back and forth until it breaks off.

3) Finally wrap a small tapered thorax, whip finish the head and trim the thread. Head cement the head and thorax for durability. A variation for this fly is to use a bead for the head.
